MANDATORY SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE (CRC § 3.1380)

A Mandatory Settlement Conference pursuant to CRC § 3.1380 is set for 01/15/2010 in Dept. 31 at 01:45 PM. Trial counsel, the parties, claims representatives and all other persons with full authority to settle the case must personally attend unless the Court has, before the Conference, authorized telephonic participation upon written application with notice to all other parties and good cause shown. A Settlement Conference Statement complying with CRC § 3.1380 must be filed with the court no later

than 01/08/2010 and served on all other parties. If the foregoing date is a court holiday or a weekend, the time is extended to the next business day.

OTHER ORDERS

If parties intend to file motions for leave to file amended complaints and/or motion for summary judgment they are advised to obtain reservations dates for hearing on law and motion calendar as soon as possible. Dept. 22 is currently setting law and motion matters for October hearings.

FURTHER CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE

A further Case Management Conference is scheduled for 11/10/2009 at 03:00 PM in Dept. 22.

Updated Case Management Statements in compliance with CRC § 3.725, on Judicial Council Form CM-110, must be filed no later than 10/26/2009. If the foregoing date is a court holiday or a weekend, the time is extended to the next business day.


All unserved parties must be served with summons/complaint/cross-complaint, a copy of this order, and proof of service filed with the court.
